Prof. Dr. T.V. Thulasidharan is a native of Piravanthoor in Kollam district. His fascination and thirst for knowledge is reflected all through his career. Prof. T. V. Thulasidharan holds masters in different disciplines and Ph.D in Education from University of Kerala. He has started his teaching career in 1992 at UCTE Pathnamathitta. In 1997 he joined as a guest faculty and later in 1999 he joined as a reader at School of Pedagogical Sciences, Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. Prof. Thulasidharan acted as principal on additional charge in University College of Teacher Education (UCTE) from 1999 to 2005, and worked as coordinator for UCTE's. He also served as a coordinator of placement cell and career counseling cell of Mahatma Gandhi University. He served as an active member of the UG, PG Board of studies of different universities. He is also the adjudicator of PhD theses of various universities.

He was a former member of Kerala State Higher Education Governing Council and a former Senate Member as well as Syndicate member in Mahatma Gandhi University Kottayam.
