

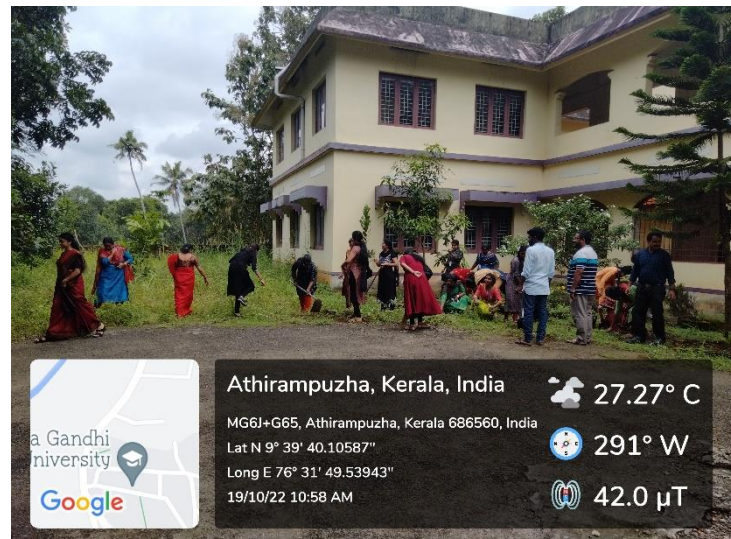
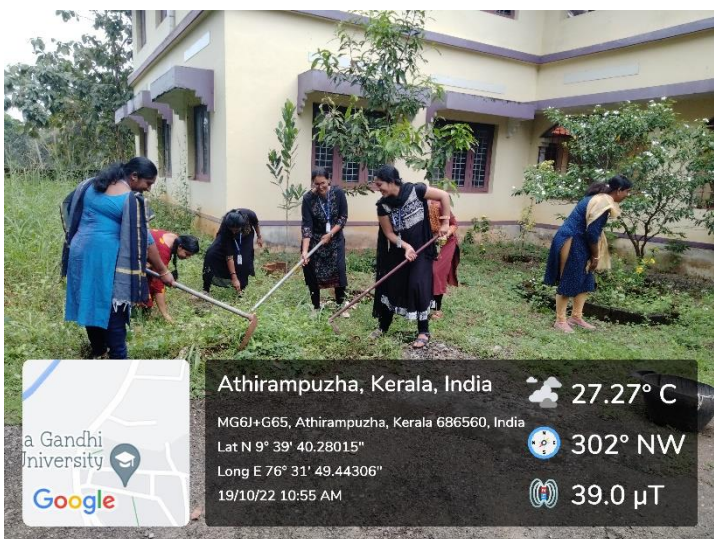

REPORT OF 'PRITHVI CLEAN AND GREEN CAMPUS DRIVE'

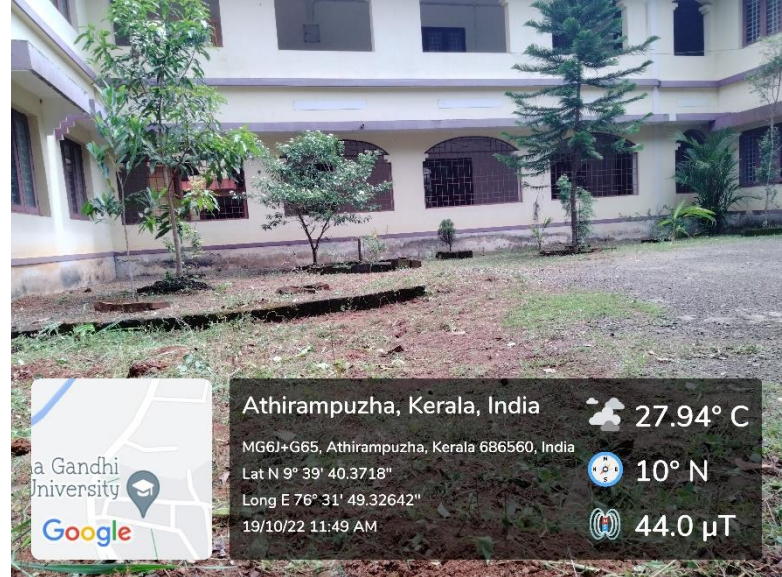
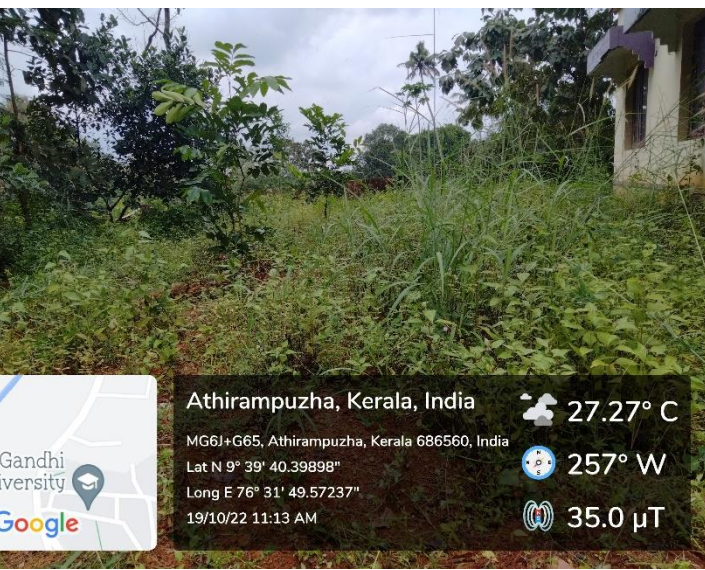
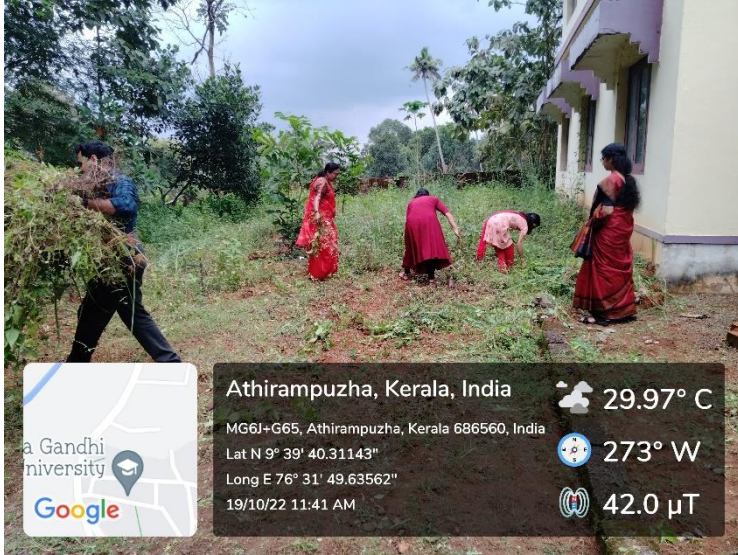
On 19 October 2022, School of Pedagogical Sciences, Mahatma Gandhi University observed a dry day as part of the 'Prithvi Clean and Green Campus Drive' initiated by Mahatma Gandhi University.

The drive was flagged off at 10 am by Prof. Dr. Minikutty A, Head of the department, under whose leadership, the students and faculty members of the School took initiative in contributing to redefining current environmental concerns. Including Prof. Dr. Asha J.V, Dean, Faculty of Education, Prof. Dr. Jaya Jaise, Prof.Dr. Sajna Jaleel, Dr. Muhammed K.V, Research Scholars and students of M.Ed Semester III, a total of around 50 students and teachers took active part in the drive.

As cleaning and greening the campus is all about turning around wasteful inefficiencies, economic and environment friendly waste disposal methods and waste handling, the students and teachers contributed to separating the degradable and non-degradable waste in the campus. All plastic waste materials were unearthed and disposed properly.
