Report of the *Workshop on Communication Skills* Date: Friday 4th October 2024, 10am to 1.15pm

The School of Pedagogical Sciences, Mahatma Gandhi University, organized a workshop on Communication Skills aimed at equipping students with effective strategies to overcome language barriers. The event sought to enhance both verbal and non-verbal communication skills, fostering personal and professional growth among participants.
